How Do 1 Get Involved?

How Are The Gifts Distributed?

The gifts are displayed in ageappropriate categories in the church sanctuary, which is decorated as if they are stepping into a department store "winter wonderland."

Parents are escorted into the gift area, where they can "shop" for an allotted number of presents for their children. (1 to 2 large gifts and 1 to 2 small gifts per child) We have stocking stuffers and other little gifts to make their Christmas complete. We also provide a full food basket and fresh produce to each family.

We have wrapping stations where volunteers will wrap the presents while the parents wait or we will provide them with all the materials for them to wrap themselves.
